If the 4 digit lunch code does not work, use the “Forgot My Password” option to reset your password through your school email.

During this time, I will still be in the classroom during normal operating hours. While I am at OCHS, I will be monitoring the progress of every student and posting grades to Infinite Campus. I will also be available to answer questions by email or phone as necessary. Furthermore, I will be utilizing our class website, mcquearyphysics.weebly.com, to provide extra material to help clarify what Edgenuity may leave unclear. Just like during normal classroom instruction, questions are vital to the learning process. Please do not hesitate to ask anything. I will only be able to respond during normal hours but will answer any question received by the next morning.
